



With 300 days of sunshine a year, the Mistral wind and exceptional sites such as the Calanques, Marseille has become **an internationally renowned sailing destination** since the 2024 Olympic Games.

EXCEPTIONAL LOCATIONS:

We're based in Marseille, in the heart of the Calanques National Park and the Olympic nautical stadium. We cover the entire coast, from the Camargue to Porquerolles, via Cassis, La Ciotat, Les Embiez, Bandol and the Côte Bleue.

THE BOATS:

We own a fleet of 18 identical Grand Surprise yachts. Light and manoeuvrable, we chose these boats because they are suitable for all types of learning situation, from discovery to sports regattas. With 8 people per boat, and a professional instructor on board, we can safely take nearly 150 people on board at any one time.

DURATION

Half a day to several days (overnight in a hotel on land). The ideal duration for this activity is a full day, but it can be done in a 3-hour half-day.

DURATION

After D-day: debriefing meeting and qualitative feedback from the teams. The phases at sea and on land can be spread over several days: for example, as part of a twoday seminar or a programme lasting several months.

TYPICAL DAY

9:00 AM	Boarding at the Mucem, welcome coffee, introduction and allocation of crews.
10:00 AM	Induction and briefing on board the boats.
10:30 AM	First tack and discovery of sailing.
11:00 AM	Exercises at sea adapted to the challenges facing the team, navigation on the Olympic nautical stadium.
12:00 AM	Back ashore on the Frioul islands, first impressions, picnic at our base or local cuisine restaurant.
01:30 PM	Resumption of the workshop at sea, cooperative game or regatta (depending on themes).
3:30 PM	Return ashore at Frioul (or Old Port to a workplace).
4:30 PM	Final report, closing remarks and cocktail reception at the end of the day.
5:00 PM	Shuttle transfer to the Old Port.
